CZECHOSLOVAKIA

8 December 1930

The Czech Explosive Materials Plant, Inc. in Prague produces a total of 5,000 tons of explosives per year, including ammonium nitrate, TNT, nitrocellulose, picric acid, bisulfate, centralit, diphenylamine, and nitric acid. The Julium Rutgers firm in Moravska Ostrava also produces picric acid, but no data are available as to the amount.

10 February 1934, "Die Chemische Industrie," No. 6

The synthesia Chemical Plant, Inc., in Prague-Sentin, belongs to the Explosive Materials Corporation.

17 March 1934, "Die Chemische Industrie," No. 11

The Czech Ammunition and Metal Plants, Inc. in Bratislava is merging with a large modern foundry and sheet brass rolling mill located in Povazska Bystrica which produces mainly shells.

3 November 1934, "Die Chemische Industrie," No. 44

The firms of Sellier and Ballot, in Prague, A. Schran, in Prague, Dynamit Nobel, Inc., in Bratislava, Jos. Rivnac and "Son, in Prague, and Schaffler and Co., in Dobsice near Znomo, have formed a cartel for the production and sale of detonators.

17 November 1934, "Die Chemische Industrie," No. 46

The Osti nad Labem Chemical Union, the Czech Explosive Materials Corporation, and the Corporation for the Production of Chemicals in Kolin are planning a joint production program for items which all three produce.

11 May 1935, "Chemische Industrie," No. 19

The Munitions Factories, formerly Sellier and Ballot, Prague, produced ammunition for hunting and for sports use, also detonators for mining. It has a factory in Riga.
