JTA – Robert F. Kennedy Jr. přirovnal to, co považuje za ohrožení lidského života ze strany 5G, očkovacích pasů a „satelitů na nízké oběžné dráze“, s hrozbou, kterou nacisté představovali pro Židy během holocaustu.

„Dokonce i v hitlerovském Německu jste mohli přejít Alpy do Švýcarska, můžete se schovat v podkroví jako Anna Franková... Dnes se zavádějí mechanismy, které to umožní, aby nikdo z nás nemohl utéct, nikdo z nás se nemohl schovat.“ řekl Kennedy během svého projevu na nedělním shromáždění proti očkování ve Washingtonu, DC.

Kennedy pokračoval ve výčtu vnímaných hrozeb „satelitů na nízké oběžné dráze“, 5G a očkovacích pasů a jmenoval Billa Gatese mezi těmi, které představují hrozbu pro soukromí a lidskou autonomii. Videoklip Kennedyho projevu sdílel na Twitteru reportér NBC Ben Collins.

Syn zavražděné liberální ikony Roberta Kennedyho a synovce zabitého amerického prezidenta Johna Kennedyho byl léta hlasitým antivaxxerem, šířil konspirační teorie a tvrdil, že vakcíny způsobují u dětí nemoci jako autismus. Kennedy byl loni z Instagramu vyhozen poté, co na platformě sdílel dezinformace o vakcínách.

Twitterový účet památníku a muzea Osvětim v Polsku reagoval na Kennedyho komentáře v nedělním tweetu. „Využití tragédie lidí, kteří trpěli, byli ponižováni, mučeni a zavražděni totalitním režimem nacistického Německa – včetně dětí jako Anne Franková – v debatě o vakcínách a omezeních během globální pandemie, je smutným příznakem morálního a intelektuálního úpadku.“ uvedl účet.

Kennedy opakovaně používal metafory související s holocaustem, aby diskutoval o svém protivakcinačním postoji. Kennedy ve své knize o vakcínách proti koronaviru vydané v loňském roce nazval jednu kapitolu „Konečné řešení: Vakcíny nebo krach“. Podle Guardianu, když byl Kennedy dotázán na název, řekl: „Nemyslím si, že vakcíny mají nic společného s vymýcením Židů.“

V roce 2015 Kennedy použil slovo „holocaust“ k popisu navrhované legislativy nařizující vakcíny pro děti a byl kritizován Anti-Defamation League. "Chci se omluvit všem, které jsem urazil tím, že jsem použil slovo 'holocaust' k popisu epidemie autismu," řekl tehdy Kennedy.
