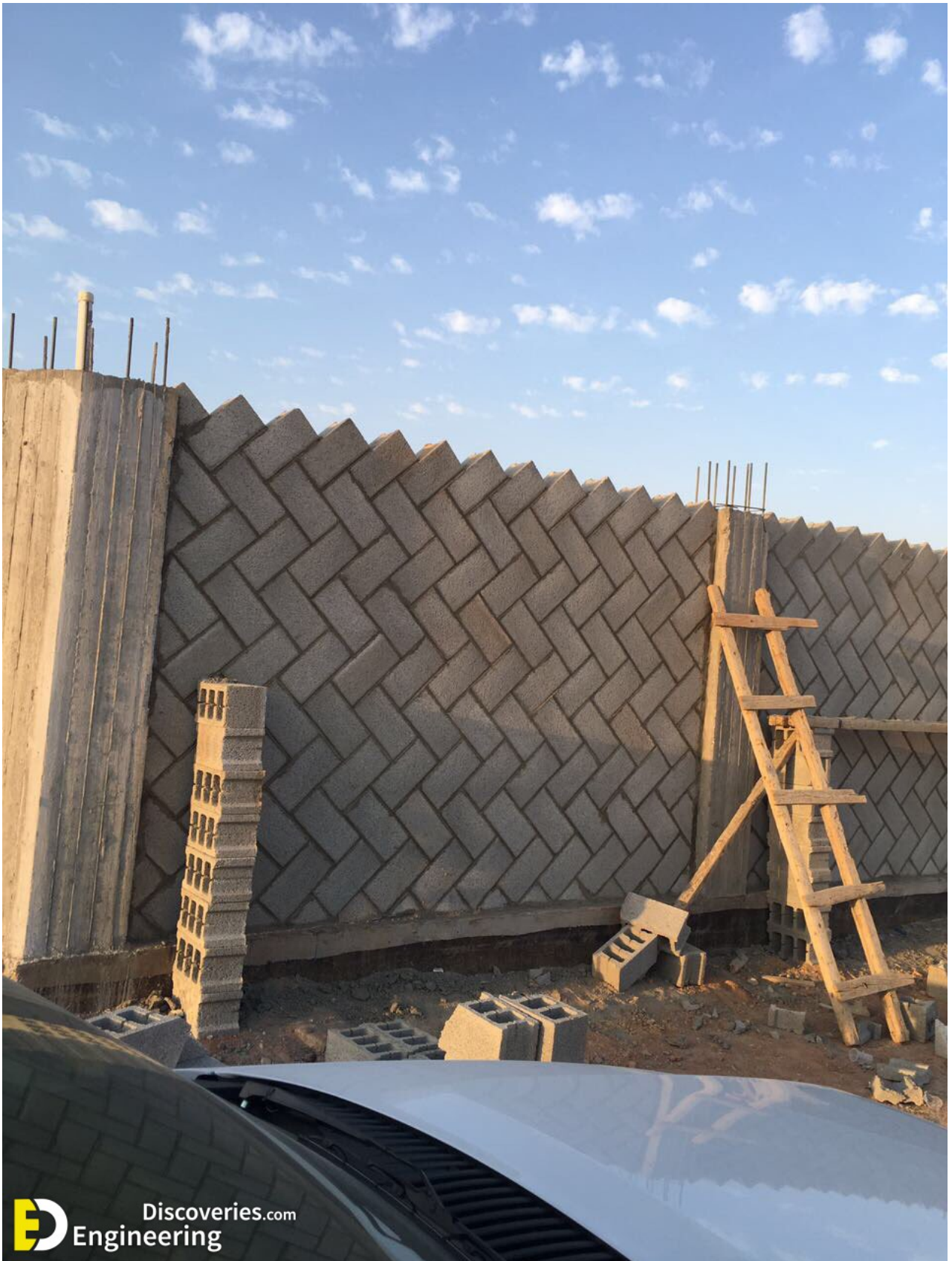
Concrete blocks are five or six times larger than bricks, so you might think that setting blocks would be about that much easier. But the blocks are heavier than bricks—about 40 pounds—and require more mortar, so there's little time or effort saved. Have the blocks delivered as close as possible to the work site, then set them along the footing so they're readily accessible. You can build a block wall by yourself, but one or two helpers will make the job easier. In this article, you will see 25 incredible concrete blocks laying in construction.

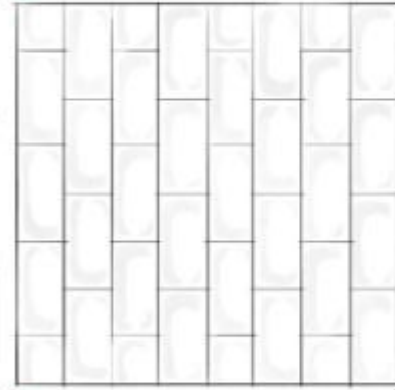
1. CROSSHATCH



2. STACK BOND



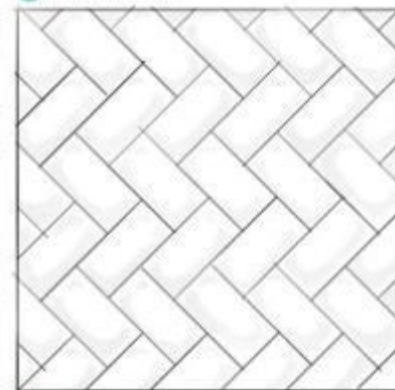
3. TRADITIONAL HERRINGBONE



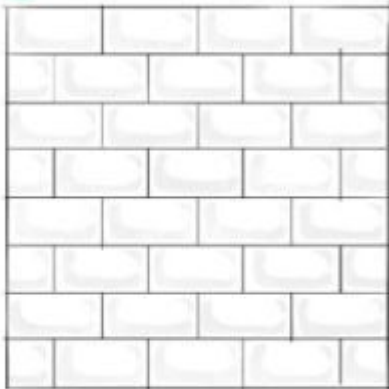
