"V Soledaru nikdo nepočítá mrtvé," dodal. "Situace je kritická. Obtížný. Držíme se toho posledního," řekl voják. ("<u>Situace ve východním ukrajinském městě je kritická"</u>, CNN)



Vidíte rozdíl v pokrytí? Už žádné historky o tom, jak "šťastliví" Ukrajinci porazí ďábelské ruské skřety. Ne. Místo toho je to chladná hořká pravda: Ukrajina prohrává a těžce prohrává. Ale jak si vysvětlíme tento náhlý "narativní posun"? A proč Washington Post poskytl platformu pro dva válečné jestřáby z administrativy George W. Bushe, aby mohli vášnivě prosit o nouzovou vojenskou podporu k odvrácení ruské zimní ofenzívy. Vojenské schopnosti a ekonomika Ukrajiny jsou nyní téměř zcela závislé na záchranných lanech ze Západu – především ze Spojených států. .. Za současných okolností by jakékoli vyjednané příměří ponechalo ruské síly v silné pozici pro obnovení invaze, kdykoli budou připraveny. To je nepřijatelné.**

Jediným způsobem, jak se vyhnout takovému scénáři, je, **že Spojené státy a jejich spojenci urychleně poskytnou Ukrajině dramatický nárůst vojenských zásob a schopností – dostatečné k odstrašení obnovené ruské ofenzívy a umožní Ukrajině zatlačit ruské síly na východě a jižní....**

Členové NATO by také měli Ukrajincům poskytnout rakety delšího doletu, pokročilé bezpilotní letouny, značné zásoby munice (včetně dělostřeleckých granátů), větší průzkumné a sledovací schopnosti a další vybavení. **Tyto schopnosti jsou potřeba během týdnů, ne měsíců...** Způsobem, jak se v budoucnu vyhnout konfrontaci s Ruskem, je pomoci Ukrajině zatlačit vetřelce už teď." Normálně jsou starší členové politického establishmentu ve svých prohlášeních zdrženlivější, ale ne zde. Tohle je čisté, nestoudné zoufalství. Rice a Gates jasně prohlašují, že Ukrajina je v zoufalé situaci, její ekonomika a infrastruktura jsou v troskách, miliony lidí uprchly ze země a většina přírodního bohatství země je pod kontrolou Ruska. Je to katastrofa; a je to katastrofa, kterou chtějí Gates a Rice řešit napumpováním dalších zbraní do zhrouceného státu, který má nulové vyhlídky na vítězství ve válce. Dává to smysl?

Vše tedy skutečně závisí na množství zásob a to v mnoha případech rozhoduje o úspěchu bitvy." Generál Zalužnyj, který buduje nový armádní sbor, stočí seznam přání. "Vím, že tohoto nepřítele dokážu porazit," říká. "Ale potřebuji zdroje. " Potřebuji 300 tanků, 600-700 IFV [bojových vozidel pěchoty], 500 houfnic." Přírůstkový arzenál, o který usiluje, je větší než celkové obrněné síly většiny evropských armád....

V soukromí však ukrajinští a západní představitelé připouštějí, že mohou být i jiné výsledky. "Můžeme a měli bychom zabrat mnohem více území," trvá na svém generál Zalužnyj. Nenápadně ale **připouští možnost, že by se ruské zálohy mohly ukázat silnější, než se očekávalo, nebo ukrajinské slabší...**

"Zdá se mi, že jsme na hraně," varuje generál Zalužnyj ... "Nepochybuji, že budou mít další cestu v Kyjevě." děti začnou mrznout," říká. "V jaké náladě budou bojovníci? Bez vody, světla a tepla, můžeme mluvit o přípravě rezerv, abychom mohli pokračovat v boji? (" Volodymyr Zelenskij a jeho generálové vysvětlují, proč válka visí na vlásku", The Economist)

Zní to jako generál, který věří ve své vyhlídky na úspěch, nebo jako vojenský vůdce, který je fatalisticky rezignovaný na porážku?

Zalužnyj říká, že potřebuje zcela novou armádu, aby vůbec mohl konkurovat Rusům. ("Potřebuji zdroje. Potřebuji 300 tanků, 600-700 IFV, 500 houfnic.") A i když budou jeho požadavky splněny, ukrajinský lid zůstane "zmrznout" ve tmě "bez vody, světla a tepla. " To je důvod, proč – podle Úřadu vysokého komisaře OSN pro uprchlíky (UNHCR) – již 8 milionů Ukrajinců uprchlo do Evropy, zatímco další 3 miliony uprchly do Ruska. (<u>Tass</u>)

Washingtonská válka proti Rusku proměnila zemi v neobyvatelnou pustinu podporovanou výhradně zahraniční charitou výměnou za rozhodný závazek vůči globalistické agendě. They are also light infantry, intended to seize lightly held terrain from an enemy that has deployed few troop in the assaulted terrain. The 101st, like all paratroopers, depends on 1) Surprise against a similar light infantry or (if luck holds)

- 1) Surprise against a similar light infantry or (if luck holds) against logistics tail troops.
- 2) Rapid relief by friendly forces, which will fend off the enemy's reaction forces. In practice, airborne units can hold out against standard infantry or even armored forces, but not for long, maybe a few days at the cost of most or all of their force.

The Russians tried taking an airport near Kiev last year (2022), the relief forces didn't arrive, and the entire airborne unit was destroyed.
