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Jen tak dál Tuckerin'

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Zastrčil se a zjistil.

Tucker Carlson, největší hvězda v historii kabelových zpráv, v pondělí zjistil, že už nemá práci ve *FOX News*, údajně jen deset minut předtím, než se zprávy dostaly do zbytku světa. Jeho pořad *Tucker Carlson Tonight* běžel v letech 2016 až 2023 a byl vůbec nejlépe hodnoceným kabelovým zpravodajským pořadem, který občas sledoval v průměru přes pět milionů diváků.

Carlson, o kterém časopis *TIME* v roce 2021 řekl, že „může být nejmocnějším konzervativcem v Americe“, v pátek uzavřel svou show a sliboval divákům, že se v pondělí vrátí, ale v pondělí byl pryč. Nedostal ani příležitost rozloučit se se svými diváky, což [jeden kritik](#) nazval „televizním ekvivalentem poprav“.

[Některé zdroje](#) říkají, že ho vyhodil nejlepší pes *FOX Rupert Murdoch*. [Jiní](#) říkají, že rozhodnutí vzešlo od Murdochova syna Lachlana a [Suzanne Scottové](#), generální ředitelky společnosti *FOX* pro gender-equity najímající se s mrtvou tváří. Carlsonova náhrada zatím nebyla jmenována. *FOX* zatím používá rotující sérii mluvících strnulých, aby zaplnil vakuum, které zůstalo po jeho nepřítomnosti.

Carlson ani *FOX* se ke konkrétním důvodům jeho sekery nevyjádřili, takže zatím je to vše spekulativní.

Někteří naznačují, že se stal tím pádem za to, že minulý týden *FOX News* urovnala žalobu, kterou proti nim společnost Dominion Voting Systems podala za [787,5 milionu dolarů](#). Dva dny po prezidentských volbách v roce



2020, což možná naznačuje, že manažeři *FOX* viděli finanční motivaci v podpoře Trumpových tvrzení o volebním podvodu, Carlson napsal producentovi:

Pracovali jsme opravdu tvrdě, abychom vybudovali to, co máme. Ti hajzlové ničí naši důvěryhodnost. Rozčiluje mě to. . . . V čem je [Trump] dobrý, je ničit věci. V tom je nesporným mistrem světa. Mohl by nás snadno zničit, kdybychom to zahráli špatně.

V týdnech po volbách, kdy se vedení stanice *FOX* pokoušelo uklidnit Trumpovu základnu tvrzením, že Dominion se podílela na podkopávání výsledků, byl Carlson jejich jediným hlasem, který křičel, že Trumpova právnička Sidney Powellová nepředložila důkazy o svých tvrzeních. 19. listopadu 2020 Carlson divákům řekl: „Když jsme stále tlačili, rozzlobila se a řekla nám, abychom ji přestali kontaktovat.“

V rámci odhalení případu vyšlo najevo, že Carlson poslal Powellovi zprávu slovy:

Neustále říkáte našim divákům, že software změnil miliony hlasů. Doufám, že to velmi brzy prokážete. Přesvědčil jste je, že Trump vyhraje. Pokud nemáte přesvědčivé důkazy o podvodu v takovém měřítku, je to kruté a bezohledné neustále říkat.

Soukromě poslal SMS moderátorce *FOX* Laure Ingraham:

Sidney Powell mimochodem lže. Chytil jsem ji. Je to šílené. . . . Naši diváci jsou dobří lidé a věří tomu.

Ačkoli byl Carlson největším lidským přínosem *FOX News*, nebyl stěží mužem společnosti. Někteří se domnívají, že ačkoli mohl být jediným čestným člověkem v síti, pokud jde o skutečnost, že Sidney Powellová nekašlala žádné důkazy pro svá tvrzení o Dominion Voting Systems, vedoucí pracovníci *FOX* a jejich pošramocené ega svalili veškerou vinu na Carlsona, že vydělat téměř miliardu dolarů jako odškodné za prosazení tohoto příběhu. Proslýchalo se, že Rupert Murdoch byl nespokojen s Carlsonovým pokrytím toho, co se stalo v Kapitolu USA 6. ledna 2021. Bývalý vůdce senátní většiny Mitch McConnell, Murdochův přítel, veřejně prohlásil, že Carlson vyvolal „urážku“. a zavádějící závěry“ o 6. lednu. V různých dobách Carlson naznačil, že událost byla federální a že Ray Epps byl závod FBI. Začátkem tohoto roku odvysílal záběry, které mu poskytl předseda Sněmovny reprezentantů Kevin McCarthy a které podkopaly Bidenovu administrativu a naléhání FBI, že událost byla přísně násilným teroristickým povstáním bělochů.

Další teorií, která se vznáší o Carlsonově propuštění, je skutečnost, že *FOX News*, která byla léta pronásledována případy sexuálního obtěžování od Rogera Ailese po Billa O'Reillyho a mnoha, mnoha dalších, byla na konci

března žalována rozhodně mužským a nepříjemně vyhlížející Abby Grossbergová, která dnes večer krátce působila jako producentka *Tuckera Carlsona*, než si vzala zdravotní dovolenou, a tvrdila, že byla fakticky zmrzačena tím, že snášela toxicky nenávidící pracoviště. Grossbergova žaloba dokáže ztělesnit každý zažitý stereotyp hysterických žen a toho, proč skutečně patří do kuchyně, bosé, zatímco kojí jedno dítě a jsou těhotné s druhým:

[Existuje] misogynní prostředí, které prostupuje Fox News a podporuje toxické pracoviště, kde pravda zůstává na útěku, zatímco zaměstnankyně jsou téměř denně verbálně porušovány jedovatým a zakořeněným patriarátem. . . . Slogan hnutí #metoo „Believe All Women“ se zjevně nedostal do Fox News. . . . Paní Grossbergová se ve Fox News setkala se systémovým šovinismem. . . . V těchto diskusích nebyla žádná žena, ať už byla republikánskou političkou nebo pracovnící ve Fox News, v bezpečí, aby se náhle nestala terčem sexistických, ponižujících komentářů, jako je například označení „kurva“.

Co kurvítko říct!

Zajímavé je, že navzdory zuřivému sexismu a objektivizaci žen, které byly údajně na jejím pracovišti uváděny, Grossbergův oblek nezmiňuje žádné muže v kanceláři, kteří by se k ní sexuálně přiblížili, ale protože snímky její tváře jsou pro diváky snadno dostupné . veřejnosti, možná jí Grossbergovi právníci doporučili, aby záležitost příliš netlačila.

Žaloba také uváděla dusné prostředí virulentního antisemitismu ve *FOX*, ale jediným „důkazem“, na který se žaloba vykašlala, byl údajný incident, kdy se spolupracovník zeptal Grossberga, zda judaismus zakazuje Židům tetování (zakazuje) a další situace, kdy jeden dělník řekl, že židovský spolupracovník šel do židovské pekárny koupit chléb a „vidět své lidi“. *Oy, to je anuddah Shoah!*

Další fáma o Carlsonově defenestraci se točí kolem náhlého zrušení minulý měsíc dva týdny starého zasnoubení 92letého Ruperta Murdocha s dentální hygienistkou Ann Lesley Smithovou, která údajně mluvila o Carlsonovi jako o „poslu od Boha“ krátce předtím, než Murdoch propukl. mimo angažmá. „Rupert Murdoch byl možná vynervován Carlsonovým mesianismem, protože odrážel světonázor na poslední časy Murdochovy bývalé snoubenky Ann Lesley Smithové,“ píše Gabriel Sherman ve *Vanity Fair*. Minulý pátek Carlson vystoupil na galavečeru k 50. výročí Heritage Foundation a hovořil o bitvě mezi „dobrem“ a „zlem“ v souvislosti s otázkami transgenderismu a potratů. "Ty věci Ruperta vyděsí," řekl zdroj *Vanity Fair*. "Nemá rád všechny duchovní řeči."

Další věc, která se pravděpodobně nebude líbit Rupertovi Murdochu ani jeho synovi, je ztráta inzerentů. Carlson, který se zdá být mezi americkými hlasateli jedinečný v tom, že se zdá, že říká, co chce, spíše než to, co se mu

říká, aby *řekl*, ztratil desítky inzerentů za to, že mluvili o Vladimíru Putinovi, ženách, imigraci, Black Lives Matter, vakcínách proti COVID, transnie, válka na Ukrajině, nekontrolovaný americký militarismus, korupce Deep State, elitní manipulace s médii, podvody bankéřů, nešikovnost GOP a zejména Velká náhrada, která je široce zesměšňována jako šílenec a důkladně vyvrácená teorie o spiknutí bílé nadřazenosti, navzdory skutečnosti, že velké noviny otevřeně otiskují úvodníky s názvy jako „Můžeme je nahradit“.

Je to jediný velký hlasatel, na kterého si vzpomenu, který je zcela nepředvídatelný a zdánlivě nekontrolovatelný. Neočekáváte, že tak vysoce postavený „konzervativec“ bude milovat Grateful Dead, že promluví na pohřbu prezidenta Hells Angels Sonnyho Bagera a řekne, že kniha od Elizabeth zarážejícího Warrena byla „jedna z nejlepších knih, jaké jsem kdy četl. na ekonomii“, aby přiznal, že se ve válce v Iráku mýlil, a aby přitáhl mezi demokraty více diváků než kterýkoli jiný televizní moderátor.

Moje oblíbená věc na něm je, že se tváří, když poslouchá někoho v jeho show, který se snaží s ním nesouhlasit. Ovládl tu tvář a říká: "Nedáváš absolutně žádný smysl, jsi zjevně duševně nemocný a já se velmi starám nejen o tvé blaho, ale i o blaho všech kolem tebe."

Včera večer ve 20:01 EST – téměř přesně v čas, kdy se jeho pořad vysílal – Carlson zveřejnil na Twitteru dvouminutové video. Zde je úplný přepis toho, co řekl:

Dobrý večer, tady Tucker Carlson. Jedna z prvních věcí, které si uvědomíte, když na pár dní vyjdete z hluku, je, kolik opravdu milých lidí je v této zemi – laskavých a slušných lidí, lidí, kterým opravdu záleží na tom, co je pravda, a také spoustu veselých lidí. Mnoho z nich. I teď musí být většina populace. Tak to je povzbuzující. Další věc, které si všimnete, když si vezmete trochu volna, je, jak neuvěřitelně hloupá je většina debat, které vidíte v televizi. Jsou zcela irelevantní. Nic neznamenají. Za pět let si ani nevzpomenete, že jsme je měli. Věřte mi jako někomu, kdo se zúčastnil.

A zároveň – a to je to úžasné – nepopíratelně velká témata, ta, která budou určovat naši budoucnost, se prakticky vůbec neřeší. Válka. Občanské svobody. Vznikající věda. Demografické změny. Firemní síla. Přírodní zdroje. Kdy jste naposledy slyšeli legitimní debatu o některém z těchto problémů? Už je to dávno. Takové debaty nejsou v médiích povoleny. Obě politické strany a jejich dárci dosáhli konsensu o tom, co pro ně prospívá, a aktivně se domlouvají na tom, aby o tom ukončili jakoukoli konverzaci.

Spojené státy najednou vypadají velmi jako stát jedné strany. To je depresivní zjištění, ale není to trvalé. Naše současná ortodoxie nevydrží. Jsou mozkově mrtví. Nikdo jim vlastně nevěří. Málokdo jimi zlepšit život. Tento okamžik je příliš směšný, než aby mohl pokračovat, a tak nebude. Odpovědní lidé to vědí. Proto jsou hysteričtí a agresivní. Oni se bojí. Vzdali se přesvědčování; uchylují se k síle.

Ale to nepůjde. Když čestní lidé říkají, co je pravda, klidně a bez rozpaků, stávají se mocnými. Zároveň se lháři, kteří se snažili umlčet, zmenšují a oni slábnou. To je železný zákon vesmíru. Právě věci vítězí. Kde stále můžete najít Američany, kteří říkají pravdivé věci? Místa už moc nezbyvá, ale nějaká jsou. A to stačí. Dokud slyšíte slova, je tu naděje. Brzy se uvidíme.
