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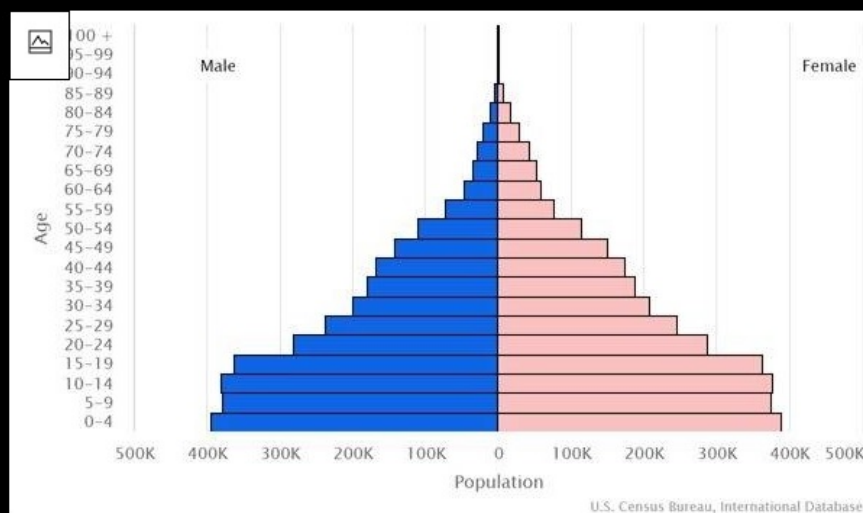

Není to ani náš bezprostřední soused. Pokud chcete do Salvadoru dojít pěšky, budete muset nejprve projít Mexikem a poté Guatemalou – asi 1200 mil od našich hranic.

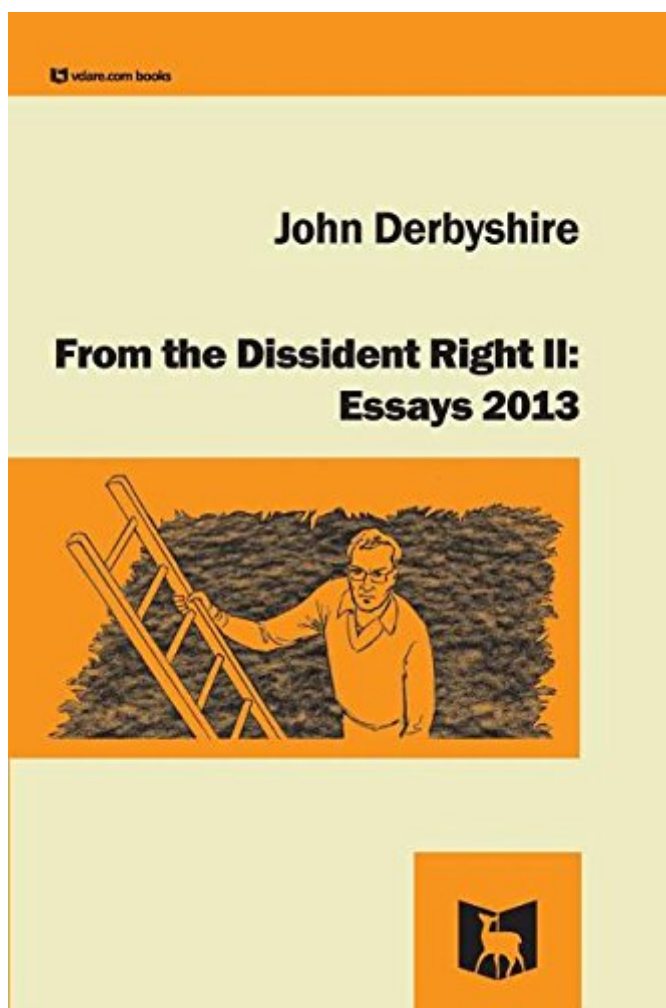
