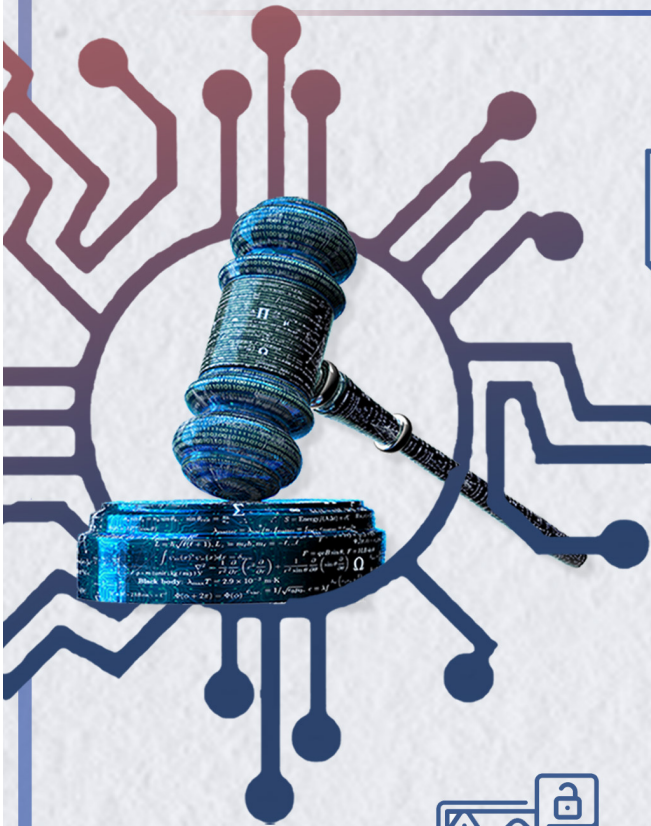

CASES OF UNFAIR COMPETITION AND MONOPOLY INVOLVING ONLINE PLATFORMS

► 2020-2021

China investigated two typical monopoly cases in e-business and online food delivery services, imposing total fines of

21.67 billion yuan
(\$3.14 bln)

► 2021

1,998 cases of unfair competition online were investigated, resulting in fines of

119 million yuan (\$17.24 mln)



GOING AFTER CYBERCRIME



► 2019-2021

129,000 people were prosecuted on charges of telecommunication and online fraud.

► 2017 - 2021

103,000 lawsuits of such fraud were concluded in the first instance,

223,000 criminals were convicted.

FIRST LIGHT 2022 OPERATION



► 2022.3-6

76 countries, including China took part in an operation codenamed **First Light 2022**



A WEBSITE FOR PROMOTING LEGAL LITERACY AMONG TEENAGERS

190,000+ schools have registered with the teenagers' legal literacy website since 2012, involving over **150 million users.**

In 2021 alone, there were

8.3 billion views on the website about the Constitution.
